XI - EUS Awards

1 Description

The Society shall give out Executive Awards, which are awards from the Executive, each year in recognition of service rendered to the Society by its members, other than in the field of sports. The EUS Executive Committee shall decide the Executive Awards. These Awards shall be separated into General Awards and Volunteer Awards. All Awards shall only be given to one recipient unless otherwise specified, with up to two runners up announced for all single recipient Awards.

2 General Awards

2.1 General

- 2.1.1 These awards shall be awarded to Active Members of the Society
- 2.1.2 These awards shall be awarded at the EUS Awards Night

2.2 The NAME TBD Award

- 2.2.1 This award is given in recognition of exceptional dedication, service and self-sacrifice by an individual or individuals in completing their duties, both within and beyond the purview of their position(s) in the Engineering community.
- 2.2.2 The recipient shall be in their graduating year.

2.3 The Department Club of the Year Award

- 2.3.1 This award is given to the Engineering Department Club which has had the most exceptional year.
- 2.3.2 This award shall take into account engagement with club members, academic advocacy, institutional improvements and growth, and any other criteria at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

2.4 The Bowinn Ma Award

- 2.4.1 This award is given to the member of EUS Council who showed the most dedication to good governance, accountability, meeting and exceeding the fiduciary duty expected of an EUS Councilor.
- 2.4.2 The award shall only take into account the accomplishments and conduct shown of the recipients within EUS Council.

2.5 Spirit Award

- 2.5.1 This award is given in recognition of the recipient's exceptional ability to motivate their peers.
- 2.5.2 This award is not to be confused with the E-WEEK Spirit Award.

2.6 Emblem Awards [Long-Term Service Awards]

- 2.6.1 These awards are awarded for service beyond that called for by the office held by the recipient, and shall take into consideration their record of service for the entire time that they have been a member of the Society.
- 2.6.2 No more than fifteen (15) Emblem Awards shall be awarded each year except at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- 2.6.3 The recipient shall be in their graduating year.

3 Volunteer Awards

3.1 General

- 3.1.1 These awards shall be awarded exclusively to EUS Volunteers
- 3.1.2 These awards shall be awarded at EUS Volunteer Appreciation Night

3.2 The Order of Godiva

- 3.2.1 The Order of Godiva shall be the Society's highest Volunteer Award.
- 3.2.2 This Award is given in recognition of the EUS Volunteer who best exemplifies the values and missions of the Society.
- 3.2.3 This Award shall take into account engagement and leadership with other EUS Volunteers, dedication to building an inclusive community, performance meeting and exceeding expectations, and any other criteria at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- 3.2.4 The recipient shall be knighted by the Executive(s) they report to.

3.3 Joey Uyesugi Award

- 3.3.1 The Joey Uyesugi Award is given in recognition of exceptional dedication and service by an EUS Volunteer, from whom it was not expected.
- 3.3.2 This Award shall take into account the expectations placed on the recipient in comparison to their exceptional work.

3.4 Rookie of the Year Award

- 3.4.1 The Rookie of the Year Award is given to the new EUS Volunteer who met and exceeded all expectations placed on them.
- 3.4.2 The recipient shall be an EUS Volunteer who was appointed to their first Manager or Director level position in the current Academic Year.

3.5 Certificate Awards [One-Year Service Awards]

- 3.5.1 These awards are to be awarded for service beyond that called for by the office held by the recipient.
- 3.5.2 No more than fifteen (15) Certificate Awards shall be awarded except at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- 3.5.3 Certificates shall take into consideration only the record of service for the year in which the award is to be made.
- 3.5.4 All engineering students shall be eligible for the Certificate awards.
- 3.5.5 The award shall be presented in two distinctions: with Gratitude and for Dedication.

3.5.5.1 Certificates with Gratitude

- 3.5.5.1.1 This certificate is awarded to those Society members showing a year of involved service.
- 3.5.5.1.2 No more than twelve (12) Certificates with Gratitude shall be awarded each year, except at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

3.5.5.2 Certificates for Dedication

- 3.5.5.2.1 The award is for Society members who continually go beyond what is required of them by their office.
- 3.5.5.2.2 No more than three (3) Certificates for Dedication shall be awarded each year, except at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
